Highway 191 Re-opens (Wednesday, July 6th)

Springerville, AZ (July 4, 2011)-
After a long and anticipated wait, Highway 191 will re-open on Wednesday, July 6 at 6 am. The highway was closed between Alpine and Clifton, AZ for safety reasons due to the Wallow Fire.

Beavercreek and Sprucedale guest ranches will re-open for guests. Guests will be

required to obtain an entry permit from the Alpine Ranger District between the hours of 8am-4:30pm, Monday through Friday. **Hanagan Meadow Lodge will be open to guests and no entry permit will be required.** Guests are reminded that the Apache National Forest is closed to all access; they must remain on guest ranch and lodge property. The forest remains closed to: reduce fire risk, prevent human-caused wildfires, protect property, and protect public health and safety during periods of high or extreme fire danger .
